

Position Opening: Artistic Director, Indianapolis Women's Chorus

Application Deadline Extended to March 15, 2010

The IndyChoruses organization is currently seeking applicants for the part-time position of Artistic Director for the Indianapolis Women's Chorus. The new director will take over responsibilities beginning July 5, 2010.

Interested applicants should possess the following characteristics:

- Commitment to musical excellence
- Demonstrated success as a choral director, with formal training in vocal pedagogy and choral literature preferred
- Acceptance and understanding of diversity in gender expression, race and beliefs
- Commitment to the mission of IndyChoruses
- Motivation to inspire the Chorus toward continued creativity and growth, to create a vision for the future and to strive for continued excellence in choral performance

Artistic Director duties are the following:

- Plan and develop a full season of performances and outreach in coordination with the Chorus, the IndyChoruses mission and its Board of Directors
- Select music and coordinate events for each performance and outreach activity
- Schedule and conduct weekly rehearsals for the Chorus and small ensemble
- Coordinate necessary accompaniment needs for rehearsals and performances
- Oversee all choral activities as expected by the IndyChoruses organization

- A resume including relevant experience and training in choral conducting and vocal pedagogy
- A cover letter including reasons for interest in this position
- A list of references including phone and e-mail contact information for each
- A sample season of programming (concert themes, pieces, composers, arrangers, where and when performed), which can be submitted in list form or with actual concert programs

- A sample recording of a chorus performance conducted by the applicant. (These will only be used by the search committee and can be archival recordings.)
